2. TCN 4990789 - ***Cryptid Kids 1. The Bawk-ness Monster*** - Monograph graphic novel record for single volume - NO PART
3. TCN 2452504 - ***Friday night lights. The first season*** (5 DVDs) - DVD /CD Set kept intact
4. TCN 1713886 - ***Fodor's Paris*** - Lovely serial record with lovely Parts
5. TCN 4065214 - ***SAT prep*** - Lovely serial record with lovely Parts
6. TCN 559593 - ***Smithsonian*** - Periodical with good and bad Parts
7. TCN 140756 - ***Sail*** - Lovely periodical with lovely Parts
8. TCN 1593923 - ***House beautiful*** - Lovely periodical with lovely Parts
9. TCN 1926361 - ***Fine woodworking*** - Periodical with good and bad Parts and Special Issues
10. TCN 4342567 - ***Baby-sitters little sister*** - Serial/open record for a graphic novel series
11. TCN 5001733 - ***Karen's haircut*** - Monograph record for just volume 7 of the above graphic novel series
12. TCN 4697833 - ***DC League of Super-Pets*** - DVD/CD set broken apart
13. TCN 2042520 - ***The outline of history*** - Multi-volume set broken apart (also discuss what if this was circulated intact - No Part)
14. TCN 4536456 - ***Moriarty the patriot*** - Open to click 'Add Holdings' and then show Part dropdown list as if I was actually adding a Part to my Item.
15. TCN 1146356 - ***Geronimo Stilton*** - Graphic novel serial record where some libraries haven't used Parts. Show trying to place a hold. It will land on 'Any Part' which is a Title Hold.
16. TCN 4016203 - ***The Legend of Zelda: Twilight Princess*** - Graphic novel serial record where some libraries haven't used Parts (Webster, Westminster). Show trying to place a hold. It will land on 'Any Part' which is a Title Hold.
17. TCN 2165445 - ***People*** - Periodical that doesn't use a Standardized Part. Multiple SEP 18 2023 Parts (including wrong ones)
18. TCN 2246688 - ***Field & Stream*** - Periodical with bad Parts that could/should be reported to the CatCenter.
